Our registered nurses and support staff address the mental, physical and emotional health concerns of students in elementary, middle and high schools in six districts within Ottawa and Allegan counties.

Services and Treatment

- Evaluate the health needs of students
- Provide illness and injury assessments and interventions
- Initiate referrals to other health care providers as needed
- Assist with medication administration
- Promote healthy lifestyles through education
- Assist in the management and education of students' chronic diseases
- Consult with providers and serve as a liaison between provider-school-family-student
- Develop individualized health plans specific to each student's needs
- Identify potential communicable diseases and assist schools with navigating concerns
- Administer training for school personnel:
 - Safe and legal medication administration
 - Emergency preparedness
 - Chronic disease management

Holland Hospital's School Nurse Program partners with the following school districts to provide nursing care and services for more than 11,000 students each school year.

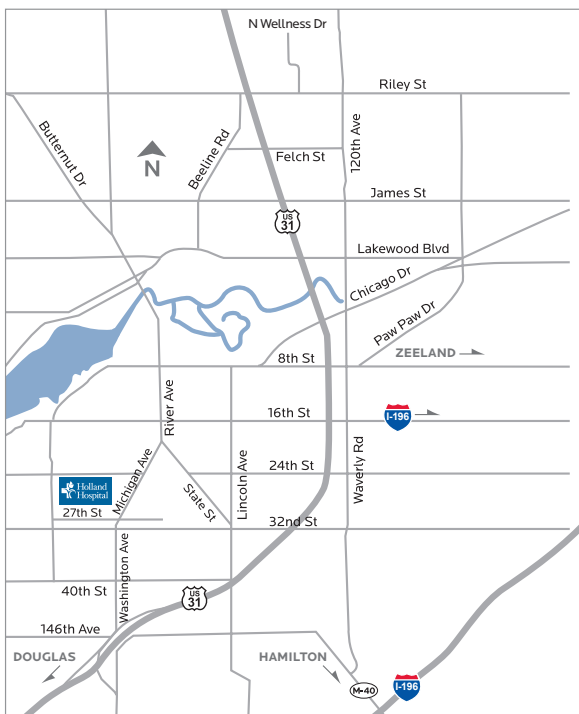
