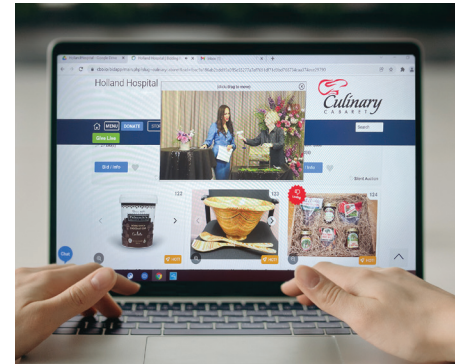

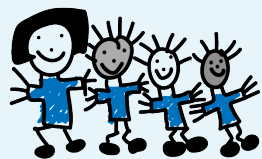

Harbor Lights Middle School, Macatawa Bay Middle School, Holland High School and Fennville Public Schools are recognized as a HeartSAFE school. A HEARTSAFE designation recognizes a school's efforts to prevent sudden cardiac death of the young (SCDY) by preparing for a cardiac emergency. Members of this school community know how to recognize the signs of a sudden cardiac arrest and respond quickly by calling 9-1-1 and using CPR and an automated external defibrillator (AED) until EMS arrives by performing cardiac drills. This is made possible by the joint efforts from the school nurse, school administrators and their emergency response teams.

Thank you to Holland Junior Welfare League for their \$579 grant for a medical training doll for tracheostomy training, gastrostomy training, urethral catheterization, stoma care, injection practice and Diastat training. School nurses can use it to train staff in tracheal tube suctioning, care of a gastrostomy button, urethral catheter insertion and PICC line emergencies without the risk of practicing on the child.



Thanks to Perrigo Charitable Foundation for their \$10,000 awarded for the RN Care Management and Behavioral Health Services at the Holland Community Health Center. Together, these two positions serve patients in a unique way that gives them a greater chance for success. The HCHC RN Care Manager enhances coordination of care, helping patients and their caregivers more effectively manage health conditions. One critical patient referral that was going unmet was behavioral (mental) health services. In 2014, HCHC funded a full-time Medical Social Worker to provide these counseling sessions onsite. This allowed patients to feel comfortable in a familiar setting with trusted staff. Since these sessions were essential for these the patients, it was determined they should be available free of charge.



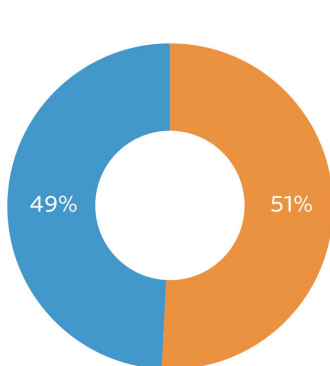

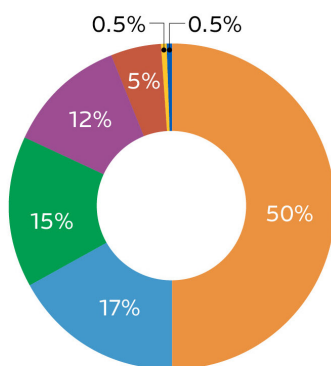

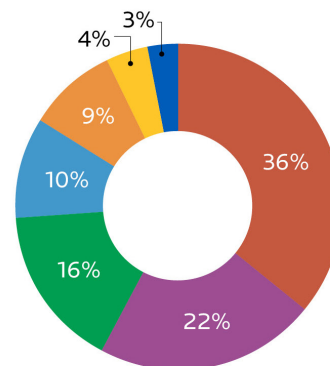
