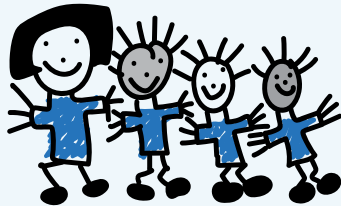
Great care is about more than medicine

Bill and Rita Vander Vliet: A Legacy of Service and Generosity

They made Holland Hospital a beneficiary in their estate plan and chose to extend their legacy of compassion and service beyond their lifetimes, ensuring that others in this community will continue to receive exceptional care close to home. 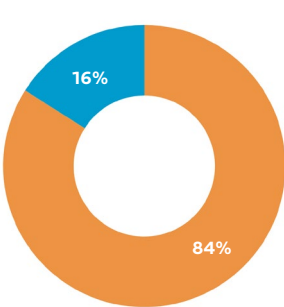

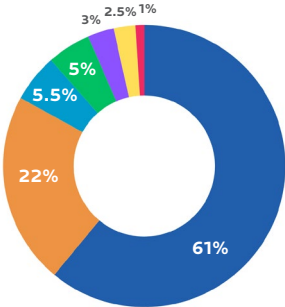

April 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026



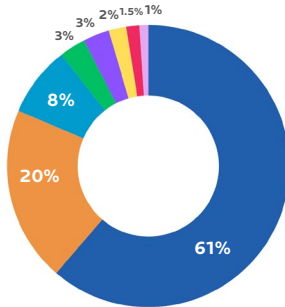
