When Natalia immigrated to the U.S., she spoke limited English and had no local support. Her children needed healthcare, and she found hope at Holland Community Health Center (HCHC). There, she was welcomed with compassion and care. The staff helped her navigate her son's autism diagnosis, empowered her to advocate for him, and connected her to vital resources.

Soon after, Natalia began receiving primary care herself, along with counseling from a medical social worker. What started as a visit for her child became a lifeline for the entire family. Today, they are thriving members of our community—thanks to the wraparound care provided by HCHC.
