
Our eight-bed Special Care Nursery (SCN) provides an advanced level of care for pre-term babies and those requiring extra monitoring and developmental support before going home. The SCN is staffed around-the-clock by dedicated pediatric hospitalist physicians and neonatal nurse practitioners. In addition, our partnership with Helen DeVos Children's Hospital provides our team with access to more than 100 pediatric specialists, should one be needed.

Your Boven Birth Center labor and delivery suite offers the comforts of home along with the latest technology. Each private room has everything needed to experience your entire birthing process— peacefully and comfortably.

After you deliver, we're devoted to making those first few days with your baby meaningful and memorable. Behavioral Health Services – (616) 355-3926


